James Kanney, a Marquette native, graduated from John D. Pierce High School. Following this, he attended Northern Michigan College of Education.

His pilot's training occurred at the Army Air Force Base Flying School at Stockton Field, California.

After receiving his pilot's wings and commission on March 10, 1943, he was assigned to duty in Dallas, Texas. From there, he was ordered to Memphis, Tennessee. On June 5, 1944, he was assigned to Kansas City, Missouri for special duty.
