After enlistment in the United States Navy, he was assigned to Naval Air Station at Corpus Christi, Texas. On May 17, 1944, he received his Wings of Gold and Commission of Ensign as a

His subsequent training occurred at Vero Beach, Florida, for eight weeks of advanced flying before assignment to carrier duty.
