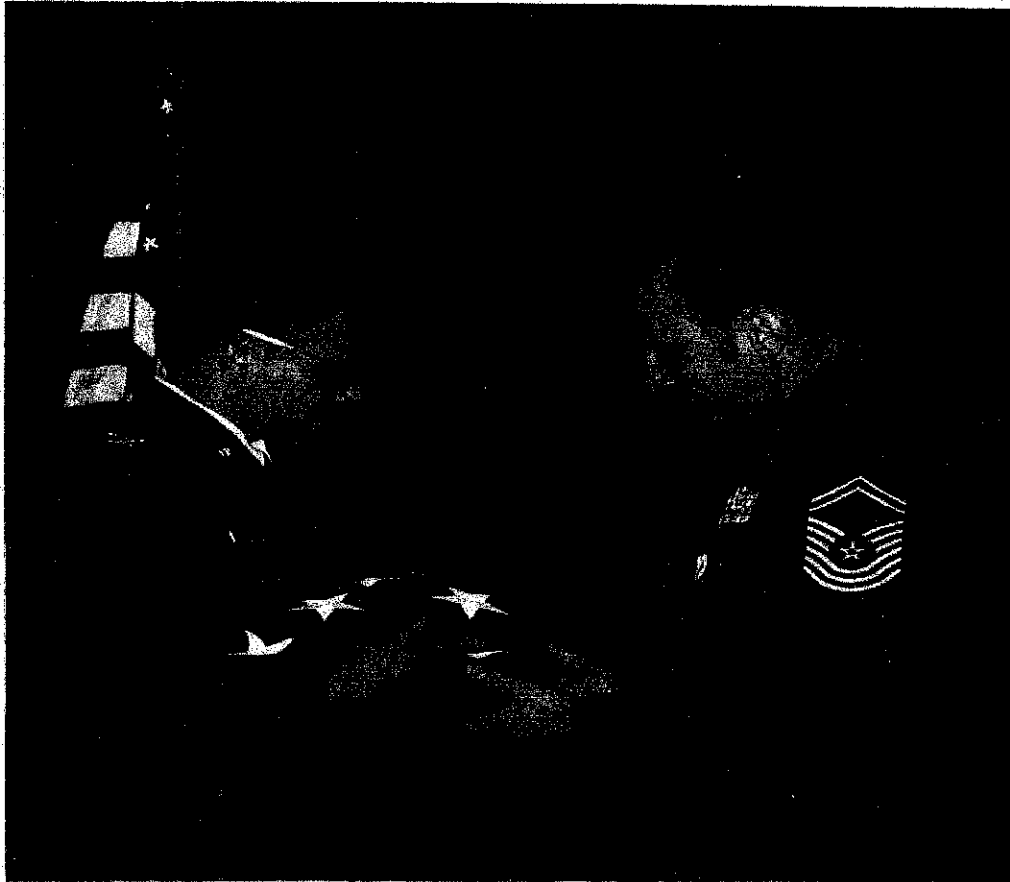


AVIATION WALL OF HONOR



Chief Master Sergeant Richard R. Harvey

Chief Master Sergeant Richard R. Harvey was born in Lackawanna, New York. He was raised in Southern California and Negaunee, Michigan. He graduated from college with a Major in Business and a Minor in Accounting. He enlisted in the Air Force in June 1962 and retired on December 1, 1985. In his career he achieved B-52 Master Aircrew Rating with 3,716.2 hours of flight time in all B-52 models. His other accomplishments are numerous and include: flight instructor status; 2AF Master Aircrew status; 146 combat missions in Vietnam during 1969-1970 and 1971-1972; 666.4 hours of combat in B-52D models; 2 Meritorious Service Medals; 6 Air Medals; 2 Air Force Commendation Medals; 6 Combat Readiness Ribbons; 7 Air Force Good Conduct Awards; 6 Expert Marksman Ribbons; Vietnam Service Ribbon; and the Vietnam Cross of Gallantry with Bronze Palm.
